

## **EU Nature Restoration Law: European Parliament gives final agreement; Council fails to honour its own political commitment**

The new law would set a target for the EU to restore at least 20% of the EU's land and sea areas by 2030, and all ecosystems in need of restoration by 2050.

Following the political agreement between EU legislators (European Parliament and Council) in the trilogue, the EP Plenary took the final formal decision on 27 February 2024.

The Council however did not honour its own political agreement, following a last-minute change of attitude by some Member States. The decision has been postponed in Council.
