IMPEL is the European Union Network for the Implementation and Enforcement of Environmental Law (IMPEL). It is organised as an international non-profit association of a total of 55 environmental authorities in 36 countries.

The association is registered in Belgium and its legal seat is in Brussels.

The IMPEL Network has just started a project on reversing groundwater pollution, a problem many European countries have.

With Germany as project leader and participants from Denmark, Estonia, Italy, Malta, Romania, Spain and the United Kingdom, the project is designed to investigate problems and possible solutions in a range of diverse European countries.
