

European Parliament questions 7 water-related questions from Parliamentarians, from large-scale animal farms to interpretation of the Urban Waste Water Treatment Directive



The European Parliament is directly elected by citizens of all Member States. One key element within its right to political control is the right to table written and oral questions to European Institutions, largely to the Commission, to a smaller extent to the Council.

Members of Parliament show a regular interest of water issues in their Parliamentary questions.

Between 13 October 2020 and 27 November 2020, a total of seven water-related questions have been tabled. The relatively low number should be seen against the background of COVID19 Lockdown Measures both in Brussels (Belgium) and in Strasbourg (France).
