European Parliament questions

23 water-related questions from Parliamentarians from trifluoroacetic acid pollution in groundwater via waste water treatment plants to pesticides.

The European Parliament is directly elected by citizens of all Member States. One key element within its right to political control is the right to table written and oral questions to European Institutions, largely to the Commission, to a smaller extent to the Council.

Members of Parliament show a regular interest of water issues in their Parliamentary questions.

Between 1 February 2021 and 12 April March 2021, 23 water-related questions have been tabled.
