European Environment Agency report "Water availability, surface water quality and water use in the Eastern Partnership countries"

The Eastern Partnership (EaP) is a joint policy initiative which aims to deepen and strengthen relations between the European Union (EU), its Member States and its six Eastern neighbours: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine.

In the context of this cooperation, the EU initiated a project on shared environmental information systems, which has seen two phases up to 2020. This demand-based project, implemented by the European Environment Agency, has supported EaP countries in accessing EU and European Environment Information and Observation Network (Eionet) knowledge and experience. Water was one of the priority thematic areas of cooperation.
