Lump sum and penalty payments to be proposed in infringement proceedings: updating of calculation data



According to the Treaty on European Union and the Treaty on Functioning of the European Union), Member States are obliged to comply with EU legislation adopted by the legislator (European Parliament and Council), and the Commission has the right and the obligation to scrutinise such compliance and where appropriate take legal action.

Where the Commission refers a Member State to the Court of Justice of the European Union for failing to fulfil an obligation under the Treaties, the Court may impose financial sanctions.
