1. Glyphosate: end of the debate (?)

Pesticide to be re-approved by Commission; Member States in the responsible Committee neither established a qualified majority for re-approval nor a qualified majority against re-approval.

NGOs announce they will legally challenge a forthcoming re-authorisation at European Courts.

2. New research results on prediction of mega-floods

When floods are predicted only on the basis of local data, there may be unpleasant surprises. A new method makes it possible to significantly improve predictions - using international data from hydrologically similar areas. The new approach has been developed within a major international research project led by Vienna University of Technology. Research results have been published in November 2023.

3. OECD paper on water-related risks in the financial system

This OECD working paper explores how the financial sector understands the concept of financial materiality as a lever for decision making on water-related climate and nature risks. The paper also looks at how regulatory and supervisory guidance considers water in the context of climate and nature risks, and finally how sustainable finance tools and initiatives can support market participants in gaining an improved understanding of water-related risks.

4. Court of Auditors Special Report "Soil" - EU efforts for sustainable soil management - Unambitious standards and limited targeting

The European Court of Auditors has, within its series of Special Reports, published a report on EU efforts for sustainable soil management.

In Europe, 60-70 % of soils are unhealthy, in part due to soil and manure management practices. The common agricultural policy and the Nitrates Directive provide tools to encourage improvements in soil and manure management.

The Court assessed whether the Commission and member states made effective use of these EU tools for managing agricultural soils and manure sustainably. The Court found that these were not used sufficiently and that there remains considerable scope to improve soil health.

The Court recommends that the Commission reviews and reports on the level of ambition of the standards, assesses the results of their implementation, reports on the targeting of common agricultural policy voluntary measures, limits the use of derogations and improves consolidated data at EU level.

5. Eurostat 2023 report on EU and sustainable development goals

Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union, has published the 2023 edition of its 7th regular report on progress towards the Sustainable Development Goals in an EU context.

Sustainable development is firmly anchored in the European Treaties and has been at the heart of European policy for a long time. The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and its 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), adopted by the UN General Assembly in September 2015, have given a new impetus to global efforts for achieving sustainable development. The EU is fully committed to playing an active role in helping to maximise progress towards the Sustainable Development Goals. This publication is the seventh of Eurostat's regular reports monitoring progress towards the SDGs in an EU context.

6. Water leakages: S&P research report "Lost Water: Challenges And Opportunities"

In this research paper, S&P Global Ratings - one of the world's leading rating agencies - looks at water infrastructure challenges through the lens of non-revenue water (NRW), meaning water that a utility sources and treats but for which it receives no financial compensation. NRW, or lost water, deters investment in water infrastructure assets. Reducing it can have many benefits, including increasing universal access to safe water, mitigating water stress, reducing the impacts of freshwater withdrawals on ecosystems, and mitigating global greenhouse gas emissions. Investment decisions made today could significantly affect future NRW rates. Yet, in many cases - particularly emerging markets- access to private-sector funding is limited and regulatory incentives are insufficient.

7. Daughter Directives to the Water Framework Directive: Amended quality standards for groundwater and for surface waters

October 2022 saw a legislative Proposal for updating/amending EU quality standards for groundwater and for surface waters (COM(2022) 540 final).

The European Parliament Plenary has on 12 September 2023 its position in 1st reading, and opened the path towards negotiations with the Council to find a so-called "1st reading solution".

8. Revision of the EU Detergents Regulation

After almost 20 years, the EU Detergents Regulation is under revision.

9. EU enlargement: 2023 state of play

9 November 2023 saw publication of the "2023 Enlargement Package", providing a detailed assessment of the state of play and the progress made by Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey, and for the first time also Ukraine, the Republic of Moldova and Georgia on their respective paths towards accession to the European Union. In particular, the report focuses on the progress in the implementation of fundamental reforms, as well as on providing clear guidance on the reform priorities ahead. Accession is and will remain a merit-based process, fully dependent on the objective progress achieved by each country.

10. Upholding the Law: update on infringement procedures

The European Union is constitutionally designed as a Union of Law. According to the Treaties (Treaty on European Union, Treaty on Functioning of the European Union), Member States are obliged to comply with EU legislation adopted by the legislator (European Parliament and Council), and the Commission has the right and the obligation to scrutinise such compliance and where appropriate take legal action.

October and November 2023 saw a range of infringement procedures, from the Waste Shipments Regulation via the Habitats Directive to the Water Framework Directive and Floods Directive, against the following Member States: Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Estonia, Germany, Greece, Poland, Portugal and Romania.
