Post-Brexit agricultural funding in the UK finally revealed

As long as the United Kingdom was member of the EU, UK farmers received **about 3.5 billion GBP a year** in farm support under the EU's Common Agricultural Policy (CAP)¹.

On 26 January 2023, UK authorities finally revealed the amount of funds and the criteria for future support for agriculture. For England, the future figures are 2.4 billion GBP a year, which together with figures for Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland means a reduction of agricultural funding - perceived in particular in Wales as contrary to repeating commitments and promises by the ruling Conservative Party.
