

Eurostat water statistics



Eurostat is the statistical office of the European Union¹, its mission defined as providing high-quality statistics and data on Europe.

Eurostat produces European statistics in partnership with National Statistical Institutes and other national authorities in the EU Member States. This partnership is known as the European Statistical System (ESS). It also includes the statistical authorities of the European Economic Area (EEA) countries and Switzerland.

Eurostat publishes inter alia water-related statistics on the countries of the European Union, countries within the European Economic Area (EEA) countries and Switzerland, and selected other countries. The relevant data and text are available at a dedicated website of Eurostat “Water statistics”². The data currently presented there have been extracted in August 2023, the next planned article update is foreseen for August 2024.
